

STABLES

THE CO-OPERATION OF ALL VISITORS IS SOUGHT TO PRESERVE AND

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

As a condition of entry to the SIEC stable compound, persons:

1. Agree to follow the direction and instruction of SIEC staff at all times whilst at the SIEC
2. Agree to adhere to all directions displayed on signage at the SIEC
3. Agree they will not do any of the following within the SIEC stable compound:
 - (a) smoke, consume alcohol, or be intoxicated in any part of the stable compound.
 - (b) use any fire hose. Penalties can apply
 - (c) be in possession of any glass whilst in, or bring any glass into, any part of the stable compound
 - (d) bring any vehicle into the stable compound unless that vehicle has been authorised by SIEC management, bicycles, scooters and golf buggies are not permitted
 - (e) enter the stable compound without enclosed footwear
 - (f) leave a horse unattended unless it is within a stable
 - (g) affix a bridle to a horse whilst the horse is in a stable as this may result in serious injury to both you and the horse
 - (h) leave a horse unattended in the lunging yards, Lunging yards are for lunging only
 - (i) take a horse outside of the stable without a bridal or headstall
 - (j) bring a dog to the SIEC without a lead. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times whilst at the SIEC
 - (k) tie a horse to trees or fences, horses should be cared for according to best accepted practice
4. Agree they will do the following within the SIEC stable compound:
 - (a) ensure persons under the age of 18 are supervised by an adult at all times
 - (b) stable horses if the horses are staying overnight

- (c) keep aisles clear of obstruction in case of an evacuation
- (d) have bedding in every stable being used to ensure animal safety and welfare
- (e) clean all stables of soiled waste daily, as a minimum requirement, and dispose of the animal waste in appropriate bins provided. Foreign material is not permitted within these bins
- (f) remove all animal waste from wash bays into the animal waste bins provided
- (g) at the conclusion of a persons stay, remove all shavings and manure from the stable used and dispose of the waste into the animal waste bins
- (h) leave the stable in a clean condition
- (i) report all incidents, accidents and damages to SIEC venue management

The SIEC may refuse admission to, or cause to be removed from, the SIEC stable compound any person that is, in the opinion of SIEC staff, intoxicated or any person that fails to abide with these conditions of entry or any other written signage at the SIEC. Persons must not remain on any part of the SIEC after having been requested to leave by a SIEC staff member
